#### Pledge of Allegiance

Deputy Supervisor David Brown made a motion to waive the reading of the August 2, 2017 minutes and Special Meeting minutes August 11 and 17th, 2017 inasmuch as all members received a copy thereof and that the minutes be accepted. 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#### **Reports:**

The Town Clerk's report together with a check in the amount of \$13,681.32 representing fees for the month of August 2017 was turned over to Supervisor Bills. ### Resolution No.53 of 2017 Special Project for Webpage

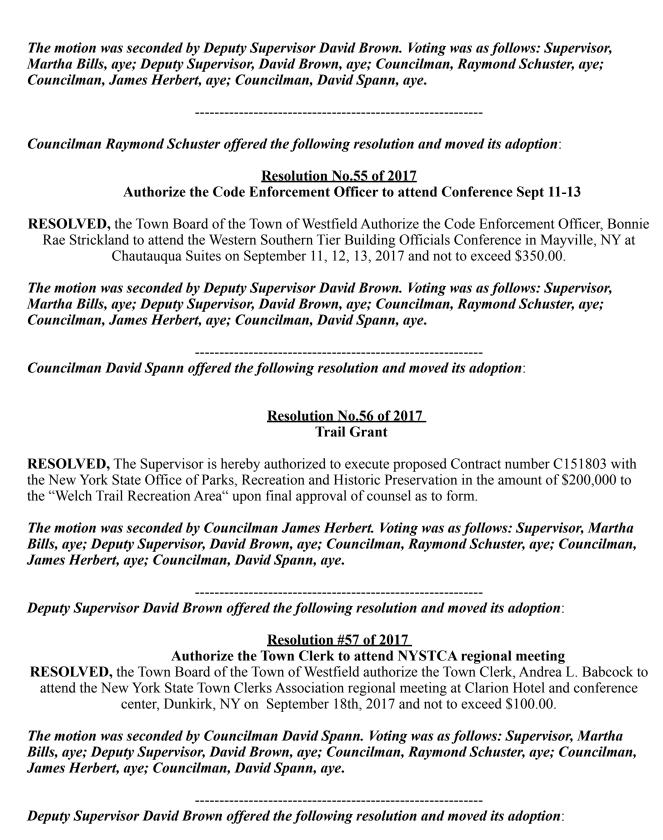
