Resolution No. 6 of 2010

Authorizations for Supervisor / Deputy Supervisor

RESOLVED, (Pursuant to Town Law, §29 [16]) that the Town Board of the Town of Westfield hereby authorizes and delegates to the Town Supervisor powers and duties of day-to-day administration and supervision of all town and special district facilities and employees consistent with and in furtherance of any and all State and Federal laws applicable thereto and with any and all local laws, resolutions or policies heretofore adopted by this Town Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Supervisor or the Deputy Supervisor be, and are hereby authorized, to sign all the necessary documents for the financing of the Town of Westfield."

Resolution No. 7 of 2010 Highway Agreement

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, the Town Board agrees that monies levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the state for the repair and improvement of highways, and specifically the sum of \$185,000 shall be expended for the general repairs of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges, or the renewal thereof, and for the following projects:

1. The oiling and stoning within the budget allotment of portions (equivalent to approximately 8 miles) of the following roads: Persons (off Route 5), Lake (off Route 5), Light (off Route 5), Walker, Culver, Jillson, and Creamery.

2. Should the Town receive funds under the Consolidated Highway Improvement Project System (CHIPS), funds estimated in the 2010 Budget (\$90,000) would be used towards completing the blacktopping project of Felton Road (from Martin Wright Road to Portland Town Line / approximately .8 miles).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no fewer than three members of the Town Board and the Highway Superintendent shall execute a certified copy of this resolution in duplicate, and said certified copy, so signed, shall constitute written agreement between the parties once it shall have been approved by the County Superintendent of Highways.

Resolution No. 8 of 2010 Appointment of Deputy Supervisor

RESOLVED, that Councilman Raymond Schuster be appointed as Deputy Supervisor for the Town of Westfield for the 2010 calendar year.

Resolution #10 of 2010 Intent to Act as Lead Agency for the Lake Erie Grape Belt Heritage Corridor Management Plan

WHEREAS, the Town of Westfield ("Town") has been identified as the appropriate entity to serve as Lead Agency for purposes of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) during the preparation of a Management Plan for the Lake Erie Grape Belt Heritage Corridor, and

WHEREAS, work on the Management Plan has begun and the Town wishes to initiate the SEQRA process, and

WHEREAS, the Town has the authority to adopt the Management Plan for the Lake Erie Grape Belt Heritage Corridor and wishes to pursue this possibility, it, therefore, makes the following determinations:

- 1. That this project will require SEQRA review.
- 2. The project is a Type I action.
- 3. That the following are potentially involved agencies: Lake Erie Grape Belt Heritage Corridor Planning Commission, NYS DEC Region 9, NYS DEC Region 9 Falconer Sub-Office, NYS DOS Office of Coastal Resources, NYS DOT Region 5, NYSORPHP, City of Dunkirk, Town of Arkwright, Town of Hanover, Town of Pomfret, Town of Portland, Town of Ripley, Town of Sheridan, Village of Brocton, Village of Forestville, Village of Fredonia, Village of Silver Creek, and the Village of Westfield.
- 4. That the Town of Westfield wishes to act as Lead Agency in accordance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 6 NYCRR Part 617.6, for the review of this project.
- 5. That the Town will circulate a lead agency coordination letter among the various potentially involved agencies, together with a copy of this resolution and Part I of the long Environmental Assessment Form (EAF), upon receipt of which the agencies shall have 30 days to submit comments on the EAF and to object or agree to this designation.

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
