Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 49 calls during the month of February. The breakdown is as follows:

## • Nine Fire Calls:

- five in the Village smoke in the building at 40 Spring Street, Springwood Apartments; a water main break at 85 Bourne Street, Mogen David; a fire alarm activation at 85 Bourne Street, Mogen David; a smoke alarm activation at 255 East Main Street; and a fire in the wall from a pellet stove at 13 Chase Street;
- three in the Town a chimney smoking at 7392 Route 20 (was wet wood in an outside stove);
  an odor of gas, South Route 394; and passerby called in smoke at 7551 Route 20, Jack's
  Welding (was furnace exhaust);
