

# MEMO

**RE:** Monthly Fire Department Report for February, 2015  
**DATE:** March 1, 2015

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 49 calls during the month of February. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Nine Fire Calls:**
  - five in the Village – smoke in the building at 40 Spring Street, Springwood Apartments; a water main break at 85 Bourne Street, Mogen David; a fire alarm activation at 85 Bourne Street, Mogen David; a smoke alarm activation at 255 East Main Street; and a fire in the wall from a pellet stove at 13 Chase Street;
  - three in the Town – a chimney smoking at 7392 Route 20 (was wet wood in an outside stove); an odor of gas, South Route 394; and passerby called in smoke at 7551 Route 20, Jack's Welding (was furnace exhaust);and
  - one Mutual Aid – possible chimney fire, 19 West Main Street, Ripley.
- **One MVA:**
  - on the NYS Thruway at mile marker 478.7 eastbound.
- **35 EMS Calls:** 20 in the Village; three in the Town; ten at Absolut Care; one on the NYS Thruway; and one Mutual Aid to Ripley.
- **One Service Call:** a water pipe broke at 92 Oak Street.
- **Three False Alarms:** two fire alarm activations at 40 South Portage Street, Patterson Library.
