**RE:** Monthly Fire Department Report for October, 2014  
**DATE:** November 1, 2014

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 45 calls during the month of October. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Five Fire Calls:**
  - four in the Village – strong odor of gas at 128 East Main Street, Crosby's; fire alarm activation at 25 Jefferson Street, Better Baked Foods; fire alarm activation at 26 Cass Street, Absolut Care; and a fire alarm activation at 58 South Portage Street, YWCA; and
  - one Mutual Aid – 7243 Prospect Station Road, Portland.
  
- **Two MVA's:**
  - one in the Town – car vs. tractor trailer at Route 20 and Hardenburg Road; and
  - one on the NYS Thruway – single vehicle at mile marker 477.1 eastbound.
  
- **37 EMS Calls:** 14 in the Village; two in the Town; one on the NYS Thruway; 19 at Absolut Care; and one stand by for Portland.
  
- **One Service Call:** lines and tree down at 7904 Route 5.
