- BeeLines articles researched, written, and published with related photos and maps in the Westfield Republican, and on Westfield Historian Facebook page for July:
  - 1. History of Portage Road and French & Indian War Part 3, referring to documents by H.C. Taylor, Sir William Johnson, and D.A.A. Nichols; 2017 photos by myself of the Marker stones and signs at North Gale/South Portage, and on Westfield/Sherman Road at Village/Town Line. (note that the N Gale markers are well cared-for and visible, but the Sherman Rd. Stone is overgrown and also needs bronze plaque cleaned.)
  - 2. History of Portage Road and French & Indian War Part 4, referring to a 1937 Grape Belt newspaper article by C. Bernard Peterson, who quotes local history buff, the late A.S. Tennant's early documents and writings; 1783-1796 Map of eastern US, which was amongst Tennant's historic materials.

Sheffield, who provides further details about young George Washington's visit to WNY area, and part in French & Indian War (part 1 of 2 BeeLines about this story); Photocopy of Map published with Sheffield story showing region of French Occupation, including the Portages.
