## VACCINATION GUIDELINES

 New York State law requires cats, dogs, and domesticated ferrets be vaccinated for rabies by age 4 months.

 1<sup>st</sup> booster required within one (1) year of first dose of rabies vaccine.




## CLINIC REQUIREMENTS

-  Animals must be accompanied by an adult.
-  Bring only healthy animals.
-  Know age and breed of animal.
-  Animals must be **3 months old** to receive first shot.
-  Dogs must be on a leash.
-  Cats must be in a container (kennel, box, etc.).

 **Certificates** are provided to owners. Copies are given to town clerks and kept by the Department of Health. Veterinarians administering shots do not keep records.

 **Unvaccinated dogs and cats**, more than 3 months of age, which come into contact with rabid animals or are involved in bite incidents, may have to be destroyed and/or their owners may be fined.
