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#### Reports

# Resolution No.59 of 2019 BID AWARD NYS ROUTE 5 WATER BENEFIT DISTRICT NO. 1

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Westfield received bids May 30, 2019 at 9:00 A.M. for the construction of approximately installation of 5,100 linear feet of new 12-inch and 850 linear feet of 8-inch watermain, valves, and hydrants along Route 5 in the Town of Westfield, New York; and

**WHEREAS**, DJM Contracting, Inc., of Hamburg, New York was the lowest responsible bidder at a cost of Seven Hundred and Six Thousand, Nine Hundred dollars and no cents (\$706,900.00) for the Base Bid (bid summary attached); and

WHEREAS, Clark Patterson Lee has completed a review of the low bidder and the bid tabulation; and

WHEREAS, Clark Patterson Lee recommends award of the contract to DJM Contracting, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, USDA Rural Development has reviewed bid documents and concur with award to DJM Contracting, Inc. per letter dated August 12, 2019; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Westfield Town Board hereby awards the bid to DJM Contracting, Inc. at a cost of Seven Hundred and Six Thousand, Nine Hundred dollars and no cents (\$706,900.00) for the Base Bid for construction of 12-inch and approximately 5,100 linear feet of 12-inch and 850 linear feet of 8-inch watermain along Route 5 as approval by the USDA-Rural Development-Rural Utility Service and the insurance and bonding being in place as approved by the Town Attorney; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Westfield Town Board hereby authorizes the Supervisor to execute the agreement with DJM Contracting, Inc. and to issue the Notice of Award once the aforementioned conditions are met.
