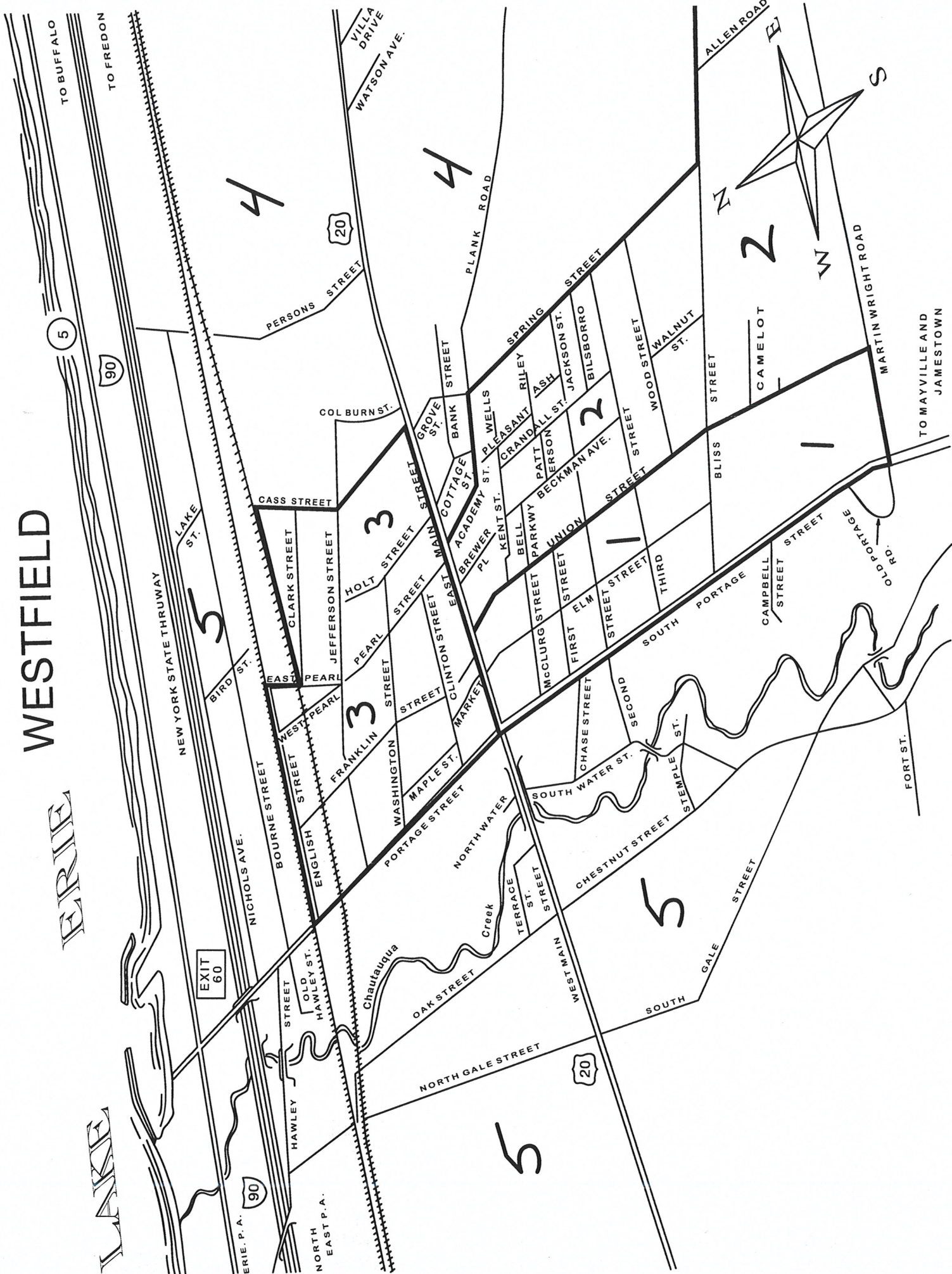

2022 Brush and Yard Waste Pick-up

This year we will continue the weekly pickup of brush and yard waste by areas (see attached map and schedule). See calendar for additional **Guidelines** and instructions.

Guidelines:

- ⇒ All pickups will be done on a **MONDAY**, except in the case of a holiday or severe weather, and then it will be done the day after.
- ⇒ **All items must be out by 7:00 AM** on the scheduled day of pickup.
- ⇒ **Please do not leave items curbside for more than one week.**
- ⇒ **No return trips** will be made until the next scheduled pickup date.
- ⇒ **Note** extra pickups scheduled during some summer months. The week before the 4th of July and the week before Labor Day.
- ⇒ Tree trimming and yard work done by contractors is **NOT INCLUDED** in pickup and this **will be** strictly enforced. **ANY and ALL CONTRACTORS** are responsible for the removal of brush and yard waste they create.

Violation will be handled as follows:

- ⇒ 1st Violation will receive a notice.
- ⇒ 2nd Violation will be excluded from all yard waste pickup for 6 Months.
- ⇒ 3rd Violations will be excluded from all yard waste pickup for a Full Year.

Description of Areas:

Area 1: Will usually be picked up on the 1st Monday. From the Intersection of Main St and Portage St: S Portage St (both sides) to Martin Wright Rd, East to Union St (including Union St Extension and Camelot Dr); both sides of Union St. down to Main St.

Area 2: Will usually be picked up on the 2nd Monday. From Union St East to Spring St and Bliss St up to Allen Rd; both sides of Spring St to Main St; Main St from Academy St. to Union St.

Area 3: Will usually be picked up on the 3rd Monday. North side of Main St from N Portage St to Cass St; both sides of Cass St to railroad tracks; going West along Clark St and English St to N Portage St; N Portage St from English St to Main St (both sides).

Area 4: Will usually be picked up on the 4th Monday. E Main St from Academy St, both sides from Spring St to Village line; Persons St, Colburn St and Jefferson St between Colburn St and Cass St.

Area 5: Will usually be picked up on the 4th Monday. Everything North of the Railroad tracks down to the Thruway. Everything West of N Portage St and S Portage St.

Note: SWIMMING POOL FILLING POLICY

- ☔ Please note that all pool fillings require advance notice using a request form.
- ☔ Water meter **must** be read before and after pool filling.
- ☔ \$4.70/1,000 gallons is the current rate for water used for swimming pool filling.
- ☔ Labor charge is also applicable.

Bourne Street Yard Waste Site**

The Bourne St Yard Waste site is located at the DPW Facility, 51 Bourne St. Hours of operation are Monday – Saturday 7:00 AM -6:00 PM May - October. It is open to the Village of Westfield Residents with a \$10.00 permit. Permits may be obtained at Village of Westfield office, Eason Hall at 23 Elm St.

The permit allows the holder to dump yard waste items such as leaves, sticks, brush, garden waste, flowers, etc.

- **No Contractors**
- **No Animal waste**
- **No Household garbage or demolition material (wood)**

**** Please note that security camera's have been installed to monitor the site. Violators will be arrested and prosecuted for Illegal Dumping**

Please remove all bags and containers after dumping. This site is self monitored and policed by the residents that use the facility. Excessive abuse and repeat complaints will force the site to be closed.

Wood mulch and wood chip piles are free for the taking at the site. Truck load deliveries may be scheduled for a fee. Call the Village of Westfield Office at 326-4961, for further information, office hours are 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM.

Topsoil, gravel or milling piles are **NOT** free. These piles are used by the PWD for restoration work. Anyone taking these items will be arrested and prosecuted.
