Enhance connections from the Downtown area to Lake Erie and to Welch Field. Provide trail extension from existing Welch Trail to Chautauqua Creek.

Signage and Wayfinding Improvements

Identify points of signage and wayfinding to create a greater sense of place.

Park Improvements

Identify potential programming within the Village's parks to improve utilization and use. Improve utilities.

Parking Lot Improvements

Determine potential parking lot improvements to improve appearance & efficiency of use.

Provide municipal wide WIFI to provide residents with higher speed internet.

Enhanced Landscape/ **Plantings**

Provide enhanced planting areas around memorial and other features within Moore Park.

Public Restrooms ili

Village to coordinate with the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) in order to plan and facilitate construction of a bathroom facility within Moore Park. (Assume 2-4 restrooms).

Enhanced Gateway

Identify strategies to create a welcoming entrance to the Main Street Corridor. Addition of 'Tree City' signage at each gateway.
